In respect of compliance report, Hon'ble High court has passed the order that

- The report shall be called on quarterly basis. The said authorities shall accordingly submit compliance report to the state Government.
- Detailed compliance reports compiled by the state Government shall be regularly placed before Hon'ble court.

In continuation to above circular, all nodal SEs/EEs are requested to submit quarterly status report within seven days of quarter ending so that the same can be submitted to Urban Development Department, Govt. of Maharashtra for further submission to Hon'ble High Court.

All SEs are to be responsible for compilation of the status report of all the divisions under their circle and submit the same in hard copy duly signed by concern EE and SE along with documentary evidences to the office of SE(HQ) on Quarterly basis.

The status report of December 2021 quarter ending shall be submitted immediately.

CIRCULAR

The Bombay high court has issued Directive while hearing PIL No. 71 of 2013 vide order dtd 20.05.2015

- 1. All nodal officers are directed to maintain all the roads & foot paths under their jurisdiction. Failure to maintain the public roads, foot paths and bridges in proper condition may lead to loss of human lives, loss of valuable working hours and waste of valuable fuel apart from the inconvenience caused to the citizens.
- 2. It is to be noted that the right to have properly maintained streets is a fundamental right of citizen.
- 3. Disciplinary action shall be initiated against the erring officers owing to failure to maintain roads, foot path & bridges under their jurisdiction.
